

Hub team look back at year

The first ever annual general meeting of the Tenterden Community Hub takes place later this month.

The committee and trustees will get together and receive the annual report, review their ambitions for the next three to five years, and appoint a new treasurer.

Kent Savers programme and project manager Mike Stephens said: "I hope the meeting attracts people with an interest in helping people by investing in the community."

The Tenterden Community Hub aims to help people of the area with social and financial problems who are struggling to make ends meet. It launched in January 2015, and became an independent charity in August.

Mr Stephens added: "We've been helping people with financial and social problems, and doing work with Kent Savers Credit Union to help people understand their finances and become self-sufficient."

The AGM is on Monday, May 22 starting at 6.30pm in the meeting room at the rear of St Mildred's Church Hall, Tenterden.
