A club that helps people struggling to make ends meet has held its first annual meeting.

Members of Tenterden Community Hub (TCH) met in St Mildred's Church, where Mike Stephens and Julia Bampton gave progress reports.

Launched as Tenterden Savers in June 2015 and registered as an independent charity in September 2016, the hub provides financial help and offers a listening ear to people in need and points them in the right direction for advice.
